AGRSS Council Announces New Board Members

The Auto Glass Replacement Safety Standards (AGRSS) Council Inc.'s Board of Directors has announced the election of several new board members.

Elected were Paul Heinauer, president, Glasspro, Charleston, S.C., and Bob Rosenfield, president, JN Phillips Auto Glass, Woburn, Mass.

Heinauer got his start in the glass industry in 1979 as a management trainee with PPG Industries, and left the company in 1986 to help launch Coast Glass Distributors in Charleston, S.C. In 1995, he sold the wholesale glass segment of the business to a long-time friend and founded Glasspro Inc. Today, Glasspro has nine locations in South Carolina.

Rosenfield has been in the industry for 25 years, having joined JN Phillips in the 1980s. He has helped grow the New England-based JN Phillips to a large chain, which now has 40 locations and more than 140 mobile service vans.

The following board members did not opt to stand for re-election and are retiring:

In addition, Debra Levy, publisher of **AGRR** magazine/glassBYTEs.com™ in Stafford, Va., and David Rohlfing, president of Glass America in Chicago, were re-elected to the board. Levy currently serves as president of the board of directors, while Rohlfing serves as vice president, both of which are volunteer positions.

The Auto Glass Replacement Safety Standards (AGRSS) Council Inc. is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to the safe replacement of auto glass. AGRSS was founded and is supported by companies in the auto glass replacement industry that keep safe installation as their primary goal. The Council is also accredited by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) – a standard development organization – and has developed North America's only auto glass replacement standard, the AGRSS Standard (ANSI/AGRSS 002-2002). The AGRSS Standard addresses procedures, education and product performance for the proper replacement of auto glass.
